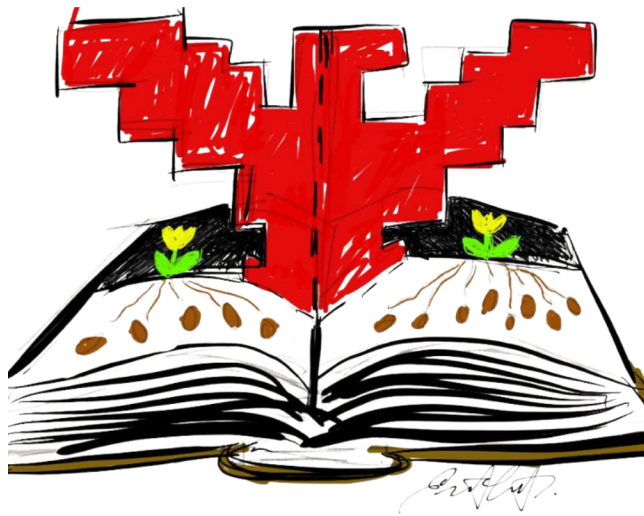

Introduced by Dr. Cati de los Ríos, UC Berkeley alumnus and Ethnic Studies professor Dr. Elias Serna unfolds the story of the Xican@ Pop-Up Book Movement, an arts allegory project which evolved out of the struggle to defend Chicanx Studies in Arizona. Pop-up manifestos and student work of banned literature proclaim, "You can ban Chicano Books, but they still Pop Up!" Commemorating 10 years of versatile education activism the XPUB multi-media lecture engages hidden histories, victims of police violence, LGBTQ "coming out" experiences, and the quincentennial of Mesoamerican cities.
